FREE Breakfast & Lunch

If your family wasn't eligible for free or reduced lunch in September, **please reapply** if household income levels are changing. Eligibility is based on the previous month's income. Forms are available in all district offices.

SIMPLE Strategies that Promote Success in School

- **Attendance** – It is vital for academic success that students attend school every day. Lessons gradually build in complexity and absences create gaps in the learning process.
- **Punctuality** – Students who are on time have access to all parts of the lesson. Students who arrive late frequently feel rushed, less prepared, and often miss the critical beginning steps of the lesson.
- **Sleep**–Children need a good night's rest every night in order to have optimal concentration at school. According to the National Sleep Foundation, elementary students (ages 5-12) need a minimum of 10 hours of sleep nightly. Preschoolers need 11-13 hours of sleep per night.
- **Healthy Breakfast** –All students (and adults) should eat a healthy breakfast every morning in order to improve energy, strength, and concentration levels throughout the day. Breakfast is available at school for students beginning at 7:45 AM daily.
