



What Does Face-to-Face (F2F) Instruction Look Like in 20/21?

Based on the Pellston Public Schools Return to Learn Plan, Face-to-Face instruction at each level would comprise the following protocols.

Elementary (K-5) Level

- Elementary will be in session 5 full days a week for face to face instruction.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to check their students' temperature each morning before sending them to school and monitor their students for the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough or shortness of breath). Students with even a slight fever (100.4 or higher) or even mild symptoms must stay home and parents should contact their health care provider and report absences to the elementary office.
- Students will be required to wear a mask or facial covering while being transported to and from school.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be mounted in every bus and students will be required to use the hand sanitizer every time they board a bus.
- Students will have assigned seats on the bus and in the classroom and will be spread out as much as possible.
- Buses will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each bus run with a Clorox 360 System.
- Students will be escorted to the classroom by staff. A prepared, boxed breakfast will be delivered to their classroom.
- Students arriving to school that do not ride the bus will be expected to go directly to their classroom.
- Students will eat their breakfast and lunch in the classroom and remain in that classroom with the same cohort of students throughout the day.
- Class sizes will be reduced to the extent possible to increase and maintain social distancing. Class sizes will be determined once we know how many students will be

returning for face-to-face instruction.

- Students are allowed but not required to wear masks while seated at their desks.
- Students will be provided a desk shield in their classroom.
- Students will be required to wear masks/facial coverings if they have to leave the classroom.
- Students will be required to use hand sanitizer anytime they enter or leave the classroom.
- Specials teachers will come to the students' classroom or be outside whenever possible.
- Students will receive recess either before or after lunch. They will be required to remain with their classmates in a designated area while on recess. Recess will be outside if at all possible. During recess the classroom desks and all frequently touched surfaces will be wiped down with an approved disinfectant or mild bleach solution.
- Playground equipment will be frequently cleaned and sanitized using the Clorox 360 System.
- At dismissal students will be escorted to the bus in a single file line with their masks/facial coverings on.
- Students will be required to use hand sanitizer as they board the bus.
- Every room and all common areas will be continuously cleaned and sanitized with plasma air scrubbers in addition to deep cleaning throughout the school day and every night.
- Indoor Assemblies will not be permitted.

Middle School/High School

- Middle School and High School will be in session 5 full days a week for face to face instruction in Phase 5.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to check their students' temperature each morning before sending them to school and monitor their students for the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough or shortness of breath). Students with even a slight fever (100.4 or higher) or even mild symptoms must stay home and parents should contact their health care provider and report absences to the high school office.
- Students will be required to wear a mask or facial covering while being transported to and from school.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be mounted in every bus and students will be required to use the hand sanitizer every time they board a bus.

- Students will have assigned seats on the bus and in the classroom and will be spread out as much as possible.
 - Buses will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each bus run with a Clorox 360 System.
 - Students will be monitored by staff as they proceed to the classroom. A prepared, boxed breakfast will be delivered to their classroom.
 - Students arriving to school that do not ride the bus will be expected to go directly to their classroom.
 - Students will eat their breakfast and lunch in the classroom.
 - Class sizes will be reduced to the extent possible to increase and maintain social distancing. Class sizes will be determined once we know how many students will be returning for face-to-face instruction.
 - Students are allowed but not required to wear masks while seated at their desks.
 - Students will be provided a desk shield in their classroom.
 - Students will be required to wear masks/facial coverings if they have to leave the classroom.
 - Students will be required to use hand sanitizer anytime they enter or leave the classroom.
 - At dismissal students will be monitored during a staggered dismissal.
 - Students will be required to use hand sanitizer as they board the bus.
 - Every room and all common areas will be continuously cleaned and sanitized with plasma air scrubbers in addition to deep cleaning throughout the school day and every night.
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- Additional safety precautions have been implemented:

1. One way traffic in hallways and staircases.
2. Staggered locker assignments.
3. Hand washing stations will be added to classrooms and hallways.
4. Hand sanitizing stations will be prevalent throughout the classrooms and hallways.
5. Elimination of bell schedule to minimize traffic in hallways.
6. Social distancing signage will be

posted throughout the building.

7. After each class student desks will be sanitized along with table tops and frequently touched surfaces.
8. Indoor assemblies will not be permitted.
